DIRECTIONS & PROCEDURES

- **Submit artwork** along with a completed **Release Form** for each entry. The current 2025 Release Form may be copied or found on REP's website at <http://www.rep4schools.com>.
- **Deliver entries** to the Redlands Unified District Office (20 W. Lugonia) c/o REP, attn.: Cherish Bohlman
- A panel of qualified judges will select the winning entries.
- Winning entries will be recognized during the Evening of Appreciation on Wednesday, May 7, 2025, at the Blackstone Theater at REV.

**DEADLINE for all artwork entries:
Friday, April 11, 2025 by 4:00 p.m.**

ARTWORK GUIDELINES

- Art entries must be created during the current school year.
- Artwork may be in the medium of the artist's choice: charcoal, pen & ink, crayon, pastels, acrylics, oil, watercolors, collage, paper, clay, etc.
- Art must be submitted on one dimensional paper, including digital art. Please submit a photograph if medium is a sculpture, multi-media collage, textile or pottery.
- We request that artwork be no larger than 11 x 17. No frames please.
- **Artwork will only be considered if accompanied by the signed Release Form.**
- Both original artwork and Release Form must be received at the District Office by Friday, April 11, 2025 at 4:00 p.m.
- All original artwork will be returned to the teacher by May 13th.
